You will need to access the following pieces:

Activity 1:

1. Listen to the opening of each 3 pieces (up to 2 mins duration of each)
2. Using the listening grid provided, list musical features associated with each.
3. On the reverse side of the listening grid, write which piece you think is the odd one out and why? (you will need to use the information from the grid to justify your answer.

Activity 2

Watch the opening 2 minutes of each piece.

1. On the reverse side of the grid explain 'What does a video of a performance add to our understanding of the music?'
