Week 1	THE GREEKS (REGGAE) Singing: Living it up in Greece (Sing Up) Composing: Reggae rhythm backing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• sing songs in a wide variety of styles, showing accuracy and expression• compose simple rhythmic accompaniment to a song using ostinato patterns
Week 2	THE ROMANS (CHA CHA) Singing: Just like a Roman Rapping: Roman Rap Composing: creating a rhythmic march ostinato using graphic symbols	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• compose music for a special occasion [e.g. march or fanfare]• perform a piece of music using graphic notation
Week 3	THE VIKINGS (ROCK 'N' ROLL) Singing: Viking words; Viking Rock; Longship Round	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• perform in a variety of styles/genres• perform a song showing an awareness of phrasing and the shape of the melody
