CONTENT	TEACHING AND LEARNING
Musical learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sing with an awareness of the phrases in a song • improvise a melody with a limited palette of notes • use tuned percussion with increasing confidence
Resources	<p>(a) THERE'S A HOLE IN MY BUCKET (Sing Up) backing track</p> <p>(b) PowerPoint slide: WHAT DID YOU HAVE FOR BREAKFAST?</p> <p>(c) YouTube clip: WHAT DOES THE WORLD HAVE FOR BREAKFAST? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ry1E1uzPSU0</p> <p>(d) Tuned percussion (try to borrow all the chime bars sets)</p>
Introduction/ warm up	Reprise SPUD RAP . Ask a group to improvise a backing using untuned percussion.
<p>Main part of the lesson to include some aspects of:</p> <p><i>Singing</i></p> <p><i>Composing</i></p> <p><i>Performing</i></p> <p><i>Listening</i></p> <p><i>Appraising</i></p>	<p>1) Display the words and play the mp3 for WHAT DID YOU HAVE FOR BREAKFAST? (words below). Sing to the tune 'There's a hole in my bucket'.</p> <p>2) Invite pupils to recall their breakfast meals and sing about these to the song pattern using the Sing Up backing track of 'There's a hole in my bucket'.</p> <p>3) Play the YouTube clip WHAT DOES THE WORLD HAVE FOR BREAKFAST? https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ry1E1uzPSU0 and enjoy the range of delicacies displayed. Notice that a simple tune accompanies this film.</p> <p>5) Remove the notes three highest (shortest) chime bars and place these in the lid. Model improvising a melody on the 5 remaining notes (use two beaters), it won't be the tune on the film but it will blend perfectly. Invite as many pupils as possible to try this improvisation activity.</p> <p>Talk about the different melodies played and critique using WWW and EBI</p>
Ideas for revisiting in the week:	<p>Involve more pupils in singing their breakfast songs.</p> <p>Encourage more pupils to improvise melodies to accompany the film clip.</p>
