YEAR 1 IPC UNIT TITLE: **MAKING NEW MATERIALS** SPRING TERM (1) LESSON 1 2 3

CONTENT	TEACHING AND LEARNING
Musical learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> perform a song showing an awareness of phrasing & the shape of the melody play a range of junk sounds with increasing confidence and ability compose music in groups using devices such as ostinati
Resources	(a) YouTube: RECYCLED MATERIAL JUNK MUSIC BAND https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=n8vvNCAK2NE (b) RECYCLE IT! (Sing Up) (c) Plastic buckets (one bucket per 3 pupils) and pairs of wooden sticks (d) PowerPoint slide: BUCKET BACKER 2 (e) WWW and EBI cards
Introduction/ warm up	ROCK, PAPER, SCISSORS! Display the lyrics, and perform the chant <u>without</u> the mp3 recording. Allocate verse and choruses to small groups to perform, adding the hand-jive actions.
Main part of the lesson to include some aspects of: Singing Composing Performing Listening Appraising	1) Perform RECYCLE IT! (Sing Up): display the lyrics and sing with the performance track or even the backing track, if the song is secure. Check that pupils have a good posture, are vocalising with controlled diction, manage controlled phrasing and are giving an energised performance! 2) Listen to RECYCLED MATERIAL JUNK MUSIC BAND (YouTube) https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=n8vvNCAK2NE observing all the recycled sound-makers being played. 3) Remind pupils of the Y3 bucket drumming activity (IPC unit: <i>Turn it up</i>). Display the PowerPoint slide BUCKET BACKER 2 and demonstrate the four playing positions: <i>top, rim, side-to-side</i> and <i>'sticks up!'</i> 5) Try playing BUCKET BACKER 2 while you listen to RECYCLE IT . The bucket part is steady – see page 2 for support in fitting this with the song lyrics: 4) Divide pupils into small groups, 3 to a bucket and encourage them to compose a rhythmic ostinato (repeated pattern) modelled on BUCKET BACKER 2 , in terms of length and the four-line structure. Share first performances and invite critique with WWW and EBI .
Ideas for revisiting in the week:	Encourage pupils to play their own bucket pieces to the backing track of RECYCLE IT!
